
The College is governed by and accountable to local churches across the evangelical spectrum and all the teaching and training is done by practitioners, rather than professionals – in other words those whose daily ministry is the teaching and preaching of the Word of God.

The need of the unbelieving world, the need of the local church, the need of the world of missions – now more than ever – is a generation of men and women who are:

- conversant with the whole Bible;
- convicted by the truths of the Bible;
- convinced of the inerrancy, infalliblity & sufficiency of the Bible;
- captivated in their own mind and heart by the Bible;
- conformed to the teaching of the Bible;
- committed to the ultimate authority of the Bible;
- confident in the supernatural power of the Bible;
- -competent in teaching & preaching their Bible in such a way that doesn't rob it of its supernatural power.

Using the phrase 'Bible Training that is Biblical' ought to warrant an accusation of tautology, of repetition of words; yet sadly today it is possible to get training that is described as Bible Training & yet is not truly biblical – either because it has little real biblical content or because much of the teaching is not truly consistent with the Bible.

Partly, but not exclusively, because of the pressure of secular academic regulators, too much time these days is taken in too many courses in studying subjects that may be about the Bible or related in some way to the Bible, but not enough time in actually studying the text, the content of the Bible itself.


This is our core course, structured around four disciplines, all of which are vital for an effective equipping and preparation for ministry.

Biblical: The Scriptures – the inspired and inerrant Word of God – are at the very heart of everything we believe, teach and practice. A large proportion of the course consists in studying the Bible, both at an overview level – stressing its unity and discovering its dominant theme – and also at the detailed level as we study individual books and passages.

Doctrinal: All Christians need to clearly grasp what they believe and why they believe it. Over the course students will engage with all the major doctrines of the Christian faith and consider something of the historical development of those truths as well as some of the ongoing debates about them.

Applied: In this part of the course students will study a range of subjects that demonstrate the practical application of biblical truth; subjects like church history, missions, preaching, and ethics. Equally importantly, a strong emphasis of the course is on the personal application of biblical truth that is designed to transform the believer into the likeness of the Saviour. Be prepared to spend quality time in prayer and worship, memorising Scripture and being challenged about your spiritual life and growth.

Practical: The best training for ministry is one in which the student gets their hands dirty, as it were. There is a learning and training that can't be done in the classroom and we provide that. There are opportunities for evangelism and outreach, public speaking and preaching. All students are formally attached to a local evangelical church where they will have opportunities to serve and learn and some of these practical aspects of the course can be carried out under the auspices of the church following discussions between the church and the College.



What Do Others Say?

The testimony of more than one of our graduates has been that as a result of studying for our core *Diploma in Applied Theology* course they have got "a bigger God and a bigger Bible". This is music to our ears and the very reason we have structured our course in this way.

We design our teaching to do three things teach the mind, touch the heart and target the will. This would be a great investment of time as you get equipped for whatever form of service and ministry you sense the Lord has prepared for you.

Finally, what does it cost? The usual cost for this course, when taken over two years, is £3,500 per year. You can download the application form for this course via our website.

Please note that as part of the application process we will require a full commendation and reference from your home church.

"If you're worried Bible College isn't for you because you're concerned about the faithfulness of teaching, or the content of the course is too demanding or intimidating, or for whatever reason, worry not! EBC isn't about academia or becoming a 'good Christian,' it's about God! And when you invest your time in God, learning about His ways and getting to know His character, you really can't go wrong. These last two years have made me forget about myself and remember that God is what everything is all about. The Advanced Ministry Apprenticeship Programme (AMAP) is a nine-month vocational training course conducted in diverse settings under the leadership of EBC staff and external mentors.

AMAP exists to transition students from the full-time college environment to full-time Christian ministry while transforming them in five key areas of personal development:- *Knowing the Scriptures, Self, People, God and Ministry Skills*.

At the AMAP's core are one or more mentored placements over a total of 25 weeks. Students will observe, participate and receive assessment in the everyday work of a minister, missionary or evangelist. Running alongside the placement ministry will be a number of assignments set by EBC staff.

The focus of the AMAP is on preparation for full-time sustainable ministry and the assignments will be set up and reviewed during three periods of on-site teaching at EBC. Students will need to achieve a total of 60 credits in order to successfully complete this apprenticeship programme.

The AMAP consists of a total of 600 hours/60 credits:

Residential Lectures & Teaching (5 weeks, 30 hours per week) 150 hours Private Study (Reading, Preparation & Follow-up Work) approximately 150 hours Placements (25 weeks, 12 hours per week) approximately 300 hours

Students' ministry and academic activities will be assessed in the field by the mentor and by EBC staff at SCQF level 9 (SVQ Level 4). Most assignments are summative assessments which are designed to measure the student's achievements. However, there are also formative assessments which provide feedback to the student regarding how she or he is developing and to encourage and steer that development. The essential elements of character, calling and competence will be the three main areas under review.

STUDENT STORY



I grew up in the countryside of County Down, Northern Ireland, in a family who knew and loved God. With a combination of their faithfulness, children's meetings and other services, and the grace of God, I came to a saving faith in Christ as a child. After God opening and closing particular doors along my life's journey, I was led to study at EBC in 2017.

After feeling the call to ministry and to spend the foreseeable time in Scotland, I started looking at Bible colleges. As I came across EBC and saw what they stood for and practised in study, everything just seemed to click for me. The key was not their advertisement as an academic institution, but a place where people are in a transformational process into the types of people God would want them to be. They also aimed to focus on some of the more practical aspects of ministry that can be lacking in other colleges.

Studying the Bible at EBC was not practised purely in an academic format, but for a deeper understanding and longing in the heart and mind for the things of God. Even if there were things I didn't fully understand, I never felt out of my depth or out of touch with the lecturers and other students, who encouraged each other in drawing as much from the Bible as possible. Coming from a quiet rural area of NI to the Scottish capital with only a vague idea of what my next steps were was perhaps confusing at times, but being part of the college has brought a sense of peace and contentment to my soul. It's just as if God has been saying to me "This is still the way, keep walking in it." (Isaiah 30:21)

We want to make our courses as widely available as possible, so almost everything we teach at EBC is also available online.

This means that you can pursue a training course from the comfort and convenience of your own home. So, even if you don't live within easy reach of the College itself, you can still benefit from our training and equipping.

This will also make study accessible for overseas students, and those who are outside the EU and so prevented from coming here for training by the current restrictions on students imposed by the UK Government.

Whether you just want to study one subject or book of the Bible, or whether you want to do a number of modules and perhaps work toward an EBC Certificate or Diploma, EBC's e-learning facility is here to help you!

How does it work? There is a simple registration form to complete. Once registered, we give you access to Moodle, our online virtual learning hub, where all our course materials are uploaded. Each module is linked to PayPal, so as soon as you make the payment, that module is unlocked and you can get started.

You can choose from a long list of modules and, as you complete each module, you gain study credits which can be accumulated, leading to an award: 120 credits will earn you a Certificate in Biblical Studies or a Certificate in Expository Preaching; 240 credits will earn you a Diploma in Theology (please ask for more details).

Included in your tuition costs is regular face-to-face time with your tutor via Zoom. If you are able to, you can even combine online studies with attending some classes at College, and so benefit from the interaction with the staff and the other students.



E-LEARNING: CERTIFICATE IN BIBLICAL STUDIES

This course can be taken over a maximum period of 5 years, accumulating sufficient study credits and can be studied at college, on-line or via a combination of both.

The Certificate in Biblical Studies includes many of the modules that are in the Diploma in Applied Theology course but leaves out the practical elements and the spiritual disciplines that require one-to-one mentoring and involvement.

All Christians need to clearly grasp what they believe and why they believe it. During this course, students will engage with all the major doctrines of the Christian faith and consider something of the historical development of those truths as well as some of the ongoing debates surrounding them.

Students will study a range of subjects that demonstrate the practical application of biblical truth; subjects like church history, missions, preaching, and ethics

In order to gain this award, a total of 120 study credits must be achieved from a combination of modules, including those that are mandatory and marked * on the list of modules on the EBC website.

I currently serve as an assistant pastor for an evangelical church in eastern Poland, in the city of Siedlce.

Pretty quickly after my conversion I was convinced that God was calling me to a preaching ministry. Because I didn't have a high enough level of theological education in Poland, our pastor suggested that I should search for a Bible college in the UK. So, we started searching for theological courses with a strong emphasis on expository preaching - that's how we found Edinburgh Bible College.

I contacted other colleges before but their reply was not very encouraging. It was not so with EBC. 




